

Additional Admission Criteria

Laddered Nursing Program (RN)

Each of the following prerequisite courses must be complete with a grade of “B-” or higher at the time the Nursing Application Packet is submitted. Please verify that these courses are complete by checking the appropriate boxes below, and checking Section 3 on Page 1 of the Nursing Application Packet. Do not submit the Nursing Application Packet if all of these courses are not complete. Prerequisite courses for the full- and part-time Laddered Nursing Program are as follows:

- Prerequisite courses completed with a grade of “B-” (2.67) or higher:
 - Chemistry 100 (Fundamentals of Chemistry I) or equivalent, or higher level chemistry course
 - Mathematics 101 (Beginning Algebra) or equivalent, or higher, or COMPASS algebra score of 40 or higher
 - Biology 201 (Human Anatomy) or equivalent, and completed within six years prior to admittance to the program
 - Biology 202 (Human Physiology) or equivalent, and completed within six years prior to admittance to the program

Please note: High school transcripts are only required for students who are using high school Algebra or Chemistry to meet prerequisite courses.

Advanced Placement (A/P) Option [for applicants who already hold LPN status and want RN status]

Each of the following prerequisite courses must be complete with the required grade at the time the Nursing Application Packet is submitted. Please verify that these courses are complete by checking the appropriate boxes below and checking Section 3 on page 1 of the Nursing Application Packet. Do not submit the Nursing Application Packet if all of these courses are not complete. Prerequisite courses for the full- and part-time Advanced Placement (A/P) Programs are as follows:

Prerequisite courses completed with a grade of "C" or higher:

- COMM 101 Interpersonal Communication OR COMM 111 Business and Technical Communications, or equivalent
- ENGL 151 Freshman Composition, or equivalent
- PSYC 201 Introduction to Psychology, or equivalent
- PSYC 220 Developmental Psychology, or equivalent

Prerequisite courses completed with a grade of "B-" or higher:

- CHEM 100 Fundamentals of Chemistry I, or equivalent, or higher level chemistry course
- MATH 101 Beginning Algebra or higher, or equivalent, or COMPASS algebra score of 40 or higher
- BIOL 201 Human Anatomy, or equivalent
- BIOL 202 Human Physiology, or equivalent
- Submission of current Michigan LPN licensure

Applicants who have completed the above criteria and the documentation listed on Page 1 will be admitted to the program according to the date of packet completion.

**Competitive Admission into the 2012/2013 Nursing Program
(NOT AVAILABLE FOR ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM)**

Competitive seats will be offered for the Associate Degree Nursing program during the 2012/2013 academic year. These additional seats will be filled based on competitive criteria. (Please see page 4 for the criteria used to rank applicants for competitive seats.) There will be seats available in both the full-time and part-time category. To be considered for a competitive seat, **IN ADDITION TO** being placed on the traditional list, you **must**:

1. Sign and date the bottom of this page to indicate that you want to be considered for a competitive seat;
2. Submit this entire Nursing Application Packet by the January 15, 2012 deadline, after completing the Nursing prerequisites as outlined on pages 1 and 2 of this packet; **and**
3. Complete the Test of Essential Academic Skills* (TEAS®) required for competitive admission, and submit the assessment results by **5:00 p.m. January 17, 2012**. If you choose to take the TEAS® at a location other than KCC, you must take **Version V (5)**, and a copy of the assessment scores must be submitted no later than **5:00 p.m. January 17, 2012**.

*The TEAS® was developed to measure basic essential skills in the academic content area domains of Reading, Mathematics, Science, and English and Language Usage. These entry level skills were deemed important for nursing program applicants by a panel of nursing program curriculum experts. The TEAS® is a 170-item, four-option, multiple-choice assessment. To prepare in an organized and efficient manner, you should know what to expect from the real assessment. Please go to www.atitesting.com to obtain information and purchase study manuals and practice tests. **Please note that there is a \$25* cost associated with the TEAS® assessment, with payment to be made at the time of testing, by credit or debit card.**

*Cost of TEAS® assessment is subject to change.

The TEAS® test will be offered at KCC on specific dates for students who have complete nursing applications. Please indicate your first, second, and third choice, and you will be registered for the test date that is available. A confirmation will be sent to your KCC e-mail account regarding the test that you have been registered for. Registration for TEAS® is a first-come first-served basis. Six (6) TEAS® sessions will be offered at KCC on the following dates:

The required competitive courses (ITEM 1) are required **IN ADDITION TO** the other Nursing prerequisites outlined on pages 1 and 2 of this packet. The TEAS® assessment results (ITEM 3) are also required to obtain a competitive seat. The general education co-requisite courses (ITEM 2) are optional, with the exception of CHEM 100, which is required to be considered an applicant to the nursing program.
