Students are required to present evidence of at least 45 clock hours of experience working with children or youth prior to their admission to the Teacher Education Program. Please note these hours must be done in a classroom setting. **A minimum cumulative 2.7 GPA must be established to be considered for admission to CMU’s Teacher Education Program.
