GENERAL EDUCATION/LIBERAL ARTS

Natural Sciences: Minimum 8 semester hours

Choose from the following in at least two disciplines; one course must include a lab: ASTR 104; BIOL 101; CHEM 100, 101,110; GEOG 100; PHYS 111, 201; SCIE 102; MATH 141.

Social Sciences: Minimum 8 semester hours

Choose from the following in at least two disciplines: ANTH 200; HIST 103, 104; PSYC 201; SOSC 101, 102; SOCI 201; POSC 200, 202.

Humanities: Minimum 8 semester hours

Choose from the following in at least two disciplines: ART 212, 213; FREN 101, 102; GERM 101, 102; HIST 103, 104; HUMA 150, 205; LITE 105-240 (except 213 & 223); PHIL 201, 202; SPAN 101, 102; THEA 121
