## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS**

**To be directly admitted to a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) program:**

**1. With an Associate Degree**

Must evidence a 2.00 (on a 4.00 scale) grade point average of college level work

**2. With 48 or more semester credits completed**

Must evidence a 2.00 or higher (on a 4.00 scale) grade point average to be eligible for general admission to the University. You will be required to submit the following documents:

- Official college transcript for each post secondary institution attended.
- ACT/SAT scores will also be required if you have not completed college-level English and algebra or 60 semester credit hours.

**3. With 12-47 semester credits completed**

Your combined GPA must be 2.0 or higher (on a 4.0 grading scale) to be eligible for general admission to the University. You will be required to submit the following documents:

- Official college transcripts from each post secondary institution attended.
- Official high school transcript (or GED).
- ACT/SAT scores will also be required if you have not completed college-level English and algebra.

**4. With less than 12 semester credits completed**

Will be admitted under the freshmen admission requirements
