**Requirements for Admission to the College of Pharmacy:**

1. Completion of all courses listed on this guide, taken at KCC and/or FSU, with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and no "D" grades in the courses of biology, chemistry, and mathematics.
2. Application to the College of Pharmacy should be submitted prior to January 31 of the year the student wishes to enter the College to ensure consideration.
3. Submission of an official Pharmacy College Admission Test (PCAT) transcript by the Psychological Corporation. It is recommended the PCAT be taken in October before the following January 31 application deadline selected by the student.

Application to take the PCAT must be made approximately one month in advance.
