ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

Admission to technical education requires a minimum 2.00 college grade point average *and* a technical associates degree with 40 major semester credits that average at least a 2.5 or occupational competency documented by the Michigan Occupational Competency Assessment Center (MOCAC). The program may be entered any semester. If a student has completed college intermediate algebra and the first two semesters of college English, successfully completing the State Basic Skills Test before entering the program would be advisable www.mttc.nesinc.com
