<i>Group II. Wellness Group Requirement (2)</i> Take one of the following: PEC 121, 150 through 160.	2
<i>Group III. Social Science Group Requirement (1)</i> Take PSYC 201, SOCI 201, SOCI 204. Take ANTH 200	12
<i>Group IV. Science and Mathematics Group Requirement (1)</i> Take a minimum of eight credit hours from at least two of the following subject areas (one must include a laboratory): ASTR 104; BIOL 101, 110, 111, 112, 116, 200, 201, 202; CHEM 200 or above; GEOG 100; MATH 122 - 242; or SCIE 100, 102, 103.	8
<i>Group V. Humanities Group Requirement (1)</i> Take courses selected from two or more of the following subject areas: ART 105, 211, 212, 213; a foreign language course; HIST 103, 104, 106, 151, 152, 201, 202, 203; HUMA 150, 200, 205; LITE 105, 205, 206, 211, 212, 216, 223, 230, 285; MUSI 211; PHIL 201, 202, 250; THEA 121, 122.	9
