### PROFESSIONAL PROGRAM ADMISSION CRITERIA

1. Application deadline is October 1 for fall entry.
2. Academic achievement. Satisfactory completion (minimum of a "C") of all prerequisite course work. Applicants must demonstrate a minimum 3.0 GPA in pre-professional program course requirements and in their last 60 hours of course work to be considered for admission.
3. Two formal letters of recommendation from appropriate health professionals. Letters from practicing Physician Assistants would be most appropriate.
4. Interviews
5. Writing samples
6. Experience. Applicants should show evidence of 250 plus hours of significant volunteer, work, or observational experience in a health care environment.
7. Maximum class accepted each fall semester is 35.

Students are accepted for Fall entrance only. Students will be informed of admission decisions by Jan. 31
