Transfer Admissions Criteria to MSU

Admission as a transfer student is based on consistent academic performance, including all grades, courses, and attempts at all previously attended institutions. Applicants with a GPA below 2.0 are not admissible. Admission consideration is stronger for applicants who have completed 28 or more credits and meet the following criteria:

- 3.0 GPA or higher.
- Completion of one year of English composition equivalent to Michigan State's Writing, Rhetoric and American Cultures course Writing: Science and Technology (WRA 110). At KCC, ENGL 151 & 152.
- Completion of a math course equivalent to MSU's College Algebra (MTH 103) or higher. At KCC, MATH 124
- Students wanting to transfer to MSU should complete the Lower Level Integrative Studies courses.
- When applying to MSU, GPA's will be recalculated including: all courses, all attempts, and all colleges.
- "C" grade will transfer if overall GPA from transfer institution is at least a 3.0.
- Students who transfer 42 or more credits must select a major.
- Transfer students are encouraged to apply at least six months prior to their desired semester of enrollment. Decisions are typically made eight to 12 weeks after all application materials are received.

Admissions Criteria for the College of Education

The Office of Admissions will review the applicant's eligibility for direct admission based on the following factors:

- Completion of 42 transferable credits.
- Minimum overall GPA of a 3.25 (including all courses, all attempts, and all schools attended).
- Completion of course work equivalent to MSU's Writing, Rhetoric, and American Cultures course Writing: Science and Technology (WRA 110) and Intermediate Algebra (MTH 1825) or higher.

Students who meet the direct admission criteria above will be asked to complete a College of Education supplemental application, submit an essay, and pay a \$20 essay scoring fee. In addition, applicants must:

- Pass the [Michigan Test for Teacher Certification \(MTTC\)](#) basic skills (reading, writing, and mathematics) test before submitting the College of Education supplemental application form. MTTC scores must be officially reported to MSU by the testing agency.
- Submit final transcripts confirming final GPA and total credits to both the Office of Admissions and the College of Education.
- Submit documentation of hours of experience with special needs students, if applying for a special education major.
