## Kellogg Community College Nursing, B.S.N.

This bachelor's degree program prepares students to function as professional nurses in a variety of hospital and community settings.

There are several options for a student to enter NMU's BSN degree program. These options include: (1) a traditional BSN degree program; (2) an LPN to BSN program (for licensed practical nurses who desire to obtain a BSN); (3) an RN to BSN degree program (for registered nurses who desire to obtain a BSN); and (4) an Accelerated BSN program designed primarily for post-baccalaureate students and students who have completed all degree requirements except Nursing courses.

To be considered for the Nursing program, students must first be admitted to NMU. After being granted general admission to NMU, students must submit a separate application to NMU's School of Nursing. A copy of this application can be found at <http://www.nmu.edu/nursing/> (click on Applications). Applications must be made by February 1 for fall entry and October 1 for winter entry. On this application, students must show they have completed pre-requisite courses, which include the courses marked with an asterisk\* on this transfer guide. Pre-requisite courses must be completed with a C- or better. A minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA is required for all options, except the Accelerated BSN program (where a 3.00 cumulative GPA is required).

*Note: Upon successful completion of challenge exams, these students are awarded advanced placement credit for their nursing license/experience. Also, an on-line BSN degree completion program is available for students who are registered nurses. For more information, call NMU's Department of Nursing at 906-227-2834.*

### Other Graduation Requirements:

1. Students can fulfill NMU's **world cultures** requirement by completing one of the following while at Kellogg Community College: ANTH 200, LITE 205, or LITE 206
2. At least one course in the Liberal Studies Program must be at the **300-level or above**. This requirement can be completed before attending the university if the transfer student selects a course that transfers at that level. At Kellogg Community College, the following courses meet this requirement: ART 213, LITE 205, LITE 206, LITE 211, or LITE 212

*Note: A maximum of 64 semester credits and an additional 4 semester credits in physical education activity courses may transfer from a two-year community or junior college.*
