Take one of the following: PEC 121, 150 through 160.

Group III. Social Science Group Requirement (3)..... 8
Take ECON 201 and 202.
Take one of the following: POSC 200, 201, 202; SOCI 201; or HIST 104 (if not used in Group V).

Group IV. Science and Mathematics Group Requirement (3)..... 8
Take MATH 124.
Take one of the following: ASTR 104; BIOL 101, 110, 111, 112, 116, 200, 201, 202;
CHEM 100 or above; GEOG 100; PHYS; SCIE 100, 102, 103, 211, or 212.

Group V. Humanities Group Requirement (3)..... 8
Take a minimum of eight credit hours from at least two of the following subject areas:
ART 105, 211, 212, 213; FREN; GERM; HIST 103, 104 (if not used in Group III), 106,
151, 152, 201, 202, 203; HUMA 150, 200, 205; JAPA; LITE 105, 205, 206, 211, 212,
216, 223, 225, 230, 285; MUSI 211, 212; PHIL 201, 202, 250; THEA 121 or 122.
