<i>Group I. Communications Group Requirement (1)</i> Take ENGL 151 and 152.	6
<i>Group II. Wellness Group Requirement</i> Take one of the following: PEC 121, 150 through 160.*	2
<i>Group III. Social Science Group Requirement (1)</i> Take one of the following: POSC 200, 201, 202; SOCI 201, or HIST 104. Take a minimum of five credit hours from the following subject areas: ANTH 200; ECON 201, 202; HIST 103, 104, 106, 151, 152, 201, 202, 203, 210; PHIL 250; SOC 201, 202, 203, 204, 250.	8
<i>Group IV. Science and Mathematics Group Requirement (1)</i> Take a minimum of four credit hours from one of the following subject areas (must include a laboratory): ASTR 104; BIOL 101, 110, 111, 112, 116, 200, 202; CHEM 100 or above; GEOG 100; PHYS; SCIE 100, 102, or 103. Take MATH 135.	8
<i>Group V. Humanities Group Requirement (1)</i> Take a minimum of eight credit hours from at least two of the following subject areas: ART 105, 211, 212, 213; HUMA 150; LITE 105 or higher; MUSI 211, 250; THEA 121 or 122.	8
