Group IV. Science and Mathematics Group Requirement (1)..... Take : BIOL 101 . Take one course: MATH 111 thru 135. Math 135 is recommended.	8
Group V. Humanities Group Requirement (1)..... Take three of the following in at least 2 subject areas: ART 105, 211, 212, 213; HUMA 150, 150H; LITE 105, 205, 206, 211, 212, 213, 216, 222, 223, 230, 240, 285 MUSI 211; THEA 121 or 122	8
Take the following: COMM 101 Interpersonal Communications (2)	3
