**Tri-State University Transfer Policy:**

Transfer credits toward a program will be determined upon the selection of a major program of study and the requirements of the selected program. Only credits earned with grades of “C” or higher may be transferred to Tri-State University. To be eligible for a baccalaureate degree, a student must earn a minimum of 30 credits at Tri-State University. The last 30 credits of a 4-year program must be taken at Tri-State.
