Social Science Group Requirement..... Take one of the following: ECON 201 or 202 Take PSYC 201 Take one course from the following: ANTH 200, HIST 103, 104; POSC 201, 210; SOC 201, SOC 202, 204.	8
Science and Mathematics Group Requirement..... Take CHEM 110, MATH 141, 142, 241, PHYS 201 and 202.	24
Humanities Group Requirement..... Take a minimum of eight credit hours from at least two of the following subject areas: ART 211, 212, 213; LITE 205, 206, 211, 212, 223, 240; MUSI 211, THEA 121.	8

Minimum grade requirement for course to transfer is a "C".
