Note: Your transfer school may require you to complete junior and senior level general education courses to meet graduation requirements.

The University of Michigan School of Nursing admits transfer students into the sophomore level of the four-year Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program. Nursing transfer students are able to build off of previously completed coursework, earn direct entry into the School of Nursing, and immediately begin the BSN curriculum.

Sophomore-level transfer students must complete at least 30 transferable credits, including the specific courses listed on the [Checklist for Undergraduate Transfer Students](#), prior to transferring to the School of Nursing.
