Group I. Communications Group Requirement	6
ENGL 151 and ENGL 152	
Group II. Wellness Group Requirement	2
Take one of the following: PEC 121, 150 through 160	
Group III. Social Science Group Requirement	8
Take three courses from the following: ANTH 200; ECON 201, 202; HIST 103, 104,151,152, 201, 202; POSC 200, 210; SOCI 201	
Group IV. Science and Mathematics Group Requirement	24
Take CHEM 110, CHEM 111, CHEM 201; *BIOL 109, 110; MATH 130 BIOL 201 (for Biomedical majors only)	
Group V. Humanities Group Requirement	8
Take three courses from the following: ART 105, 211, 212, 213; HUMA 150 or 150H; LITE 105, 205,206, 211, 212, 213, 216, 222, 223, 230, 240, 285; MUSI 211, 250, THEA 121,122	

Completion of course requirements in Groups I, III, IV and V satisfies the MACRAO Agreement between KCC and Western Michigan University.

Take all of the following:

MATH 141	Calculus I	5
PHYS 111	Introduction to Physics I	4
PHYS 112	Introduction to Physics II	4

Take one of the following:

FREN; GERM; JAPA; or SPAN	Foreign Language	8
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WMU requires two consecutive semesters of the same foreign language.

This requirement may be completed by WMU proficiency examination, or by two years of a foreign language in high school with a "B-" or better in the final semester.

Note: A minimum of a 2.0 (C) grade is required courses counted towards the major and minor.

Students may complete SOCI 202, 203 or PSYC 201 to fulfill the Healthy Living requirement for an Associate in Science degree.

NOTE: Students will need to complete COMM 101 to satisfy KCC graduation requirements for all Associate degrees. Please consider this requirement when speaking to an Academic Advisor regarding your options for completing your transfer program.
