Take one of the following (selection must include a laboratory if not taken above):

or SCIE 102.

Group V. Humanities Group Requirement..... 8

Take from the following: ART 211, 212, 213; HUMA 150; LITE 105, 216;

MUSI 211; THEA 121 or 122.

Core Requirements:

1. Acceptance to the upper division business program requires completion of:
2. A minimum of 48 semester hours of credit with a 2.50 grade point average for any work completed through Western Michigan University;
3. The following ten courses:

A minimum grade of "C" is required in each of the following 10 Courses: (Computers; Freshman Writing; Introduction to Business; Principles of Accounting I & II; Finite Mathematics OR Pre-Calculus OR Calculus; Micro and Macroeconomics; Statistics; and Behavioral Science)

Admission to the University as a PBA student prompts invitations to new transfer students to attend HCOB Transfer Advising Days. Registration for courses, as well as initiation of steps #2 and #3 will be completed with an HCOB academic advisor during HCOB Transfer Advising days. Students should be encouraged to APPLY for University admission EARLY!

Completion of the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree includes additional core courses, which may be completed at the community college or at Western Michigan University. These courses (Macroeconomics, Principles of Accounting II, and Marketing) may be prerequisite to major area courses and should be completed as soon as possible in the student's program. Students may also take these courses for transfer.
