 Take one of the following: HIST 103, 104; POSC 200, 201; SOCI 204
 Take one of the following: ANTH 200; HIST 201, 202
 Take one of the following: ECON 201, 202; HIST 106, 210, 220; POSC 210, 211

Group IV. Science and Mathematics Group Requirement..... 4
 Take one of the following: ASTR 104; BIOL 101, 110, 111, 112; CHEM 100, 110;
 GEOG 100; PHYS 111, 201; or SCIE 102

Select one course from the following:
 MATH 111, 124, 128, 130, 135, 140, or 141 4

Group V. Humanities Group Requirement..... 8
 Take two of following: ART 211, 212, 213; HUMA 105; LITE 150, 216; MUSI 211;
 THEA 121 or 122
 Take one of the following: LITE 205, 206, 211, 212, 213, 222, 223, 285;

Completion of course requirements in Groups I, III, IV and V satisfies the MACRAO Agreement between KCC and Western Michigan University for freshman and sophomore general education courses.

Take all of the following:

CRJU 101 Introduction to Criminal Justice 3

CRJU 104 and 105 Introduction to Corrections/Institutional Corrections 6

SOCI 201 Introduction to Sociology 3

FREN; GERM; JAPA; or SPAN Foreign Language 8

*WMU requires two consecutive semesters of the same foreign language.
 This requirement may be completed by WMU proficiency examination, or by two years of a foreign language in high school with a "B-" or better in the final semester.*
