Take two courses from the following: ANTH 200; ECON 201, 202; HIST 103, 104, 151, 152, 201, 202; POSC 200, 200H, 210

Group IV. Science and Mathematics Group Requirement 8
Take: MATH 121
Take: BIOL 101

Group V. Humanities Group Requirement (1)..... 8
Take three courses from the following: ART 211, 212, 213; HUMA 150 or 150H; LITE 105, 205, 206, 211, 212, 216, 223, 230, 285; MUSI 211, 250, THEA 121, 122
*Not required at WMU. Needed for MACRAO stamp.
