Minimum Required Credits

Group I. Communications Group Requirement..... 6
Take ENGL 151 and 152.

Group II. Wellness Group Requirement..... 2
Take one of the following: PEC 121, or 150 through 160.

Group III. Social Science 8
Take one of the following: HIST 103, 104, 104H; POSC 200, 201; SOCI 204, or 250
Take one of the following: ANTH 200; or HIST 203
Take one of the following: ECON 201, 202; HIST 106, 200, 201, 210, 220, 231; POSC 200, 210, 211; or SOCI 201.

Group IV. Science and Math 8
Take one of the following: ASTR 104; BIOL 101, 110, 111, 112; CHEM 100, 110; GEOG 100; PHYS 111, 114, 201; or SCIE 102.
Take one of the following: MATH 111, 122, 124, 128, 130, 135, 140, or 141.

Group V. Humanities..... 8
Take all of the following: LITE 105, 211; ENGL 203.

Take one of the following: LITE 205, 206, 212, 223, or 240.

Take the following:
COMM 101 Foundations of Interpersonal Communications 3
MATH Quantitative Reasoning 3-4
Take one of the following if a math minor is not selected:
MATH 111, 122, 124, 128, 130, 135, 140 or 141.

Completion of course requirements in Groups I, III, IV and V satisfies the MACRAO Agreement between KCC and (*put name of college*) for freshman and sophomore general education courses.

FREN; GERM; JAPA; or SPAN Foreign Language 8
(Note: May be completed by WMU proficiency examination or by two years of a foreign language in high school with a "B" or better in the final semester.)
