**Group I. Communications Group Requirement** ..... 6  
 Take ENGL 151 and 152.

**Group II. Wellness Group Requirement**..... 2  
 Take PEC 121, or 150 through 160.

**Group III. Social Science Group Requirement** ..... 8  
 Take ANTH 200.  
 Take HIST 151 or 152.  
 Take HIST 201 or 202.

**Group IV. Science and Mathematics Group Requirement** ..... 8  
 Take MATH 111, 122, 124, 128, 130, 135, 140, or 141.  
 Take GEOG 100.

**Group V. Humanities Group Requirement** ..... 8  
 Take LITE 105.  
 Take two courses from the following: ART 105, 211, 212, 213; HUMA 150 or 150H; LITE 205, 206, 211, 212, 213, 216, 222, 223, 230, 240, 285; MUSI 211, 250, THEA 121,122

Completion of course requirements in Groups I, III, IV and V satisfies the MACRAO Agreement between KCC and Western Michigan University.

HIST 103 or HIST 104	American Foundations Modern America	3
POSC 201	American Government (Federal)	3
SOCI 201	Introduction to Sociology	3
FREN; GERM; JAPA; or SPAN	Foreign language courses	8

*WMU requires two consecutive semesters of the same foreign language.  
 This requirement may be completed by WMU proficiency examination, or by two years of a foreign language in high school with a "B-" or better in the final semester. (Not required of Secondary Education majors)*

NOTE: EDUC 200 is required if you are majoring in Secondary Education. See a KCC advisor for information regarding admission and acceptance into the Secondary Education program.

All History major/minor courses require a "C" or better.
