\* Select MATH 111 if you elect the Elementary Education Certification.

NOTE: Because the course work in the Speech Pathology and Audiology Major must be taken in sequential order, and most registrations are offered once a year only, **students should plan to transfer to Western Michigan University after the Freshman year** (completion of approximately 30 hours). **Early application is important** for students to begin the undergraduate program.

**Admission requirements for Speech Pathology and Audiology:**

To be considered for admission to the speech pathology and audiology major, a student must: Schedule an appointment and be advised by the department undergraduate advisor. Complete at least 40 semester hours of general university coursework, as specified by the program, earning a minimum GPA of 2.75.

- *Minimum* grade of B\* in both:
  - SPPA 2000 Communication Disorders and Sciences or equivalent
  - ENGL 1050 Thought and Writing or equivalent
- *Minimum* grade of C\* in the following (must have taken at least two of these courses):
  - BIOS 1120 Principles of Biology or equivalent
  - PHYS 1070 Elementary Physics and 1080 Elementary Physics lab or equivalents
  - MATH 1140 Excursions in Mathematics or equivalent  
or MATH 1500 Number Concepts for the Elementary/Middle School Teacher or equivalent
- Documented observation of a practicing speech-language pathologist or audiologist. If a student has observed more than one professional, report only primary observation.
- Documented volunteer experience in a healthcare or educational setting. If a student has more than one volunteer experience, report only the primary experience.
- Complete and submit an application for admission to the undergraduate major; due date is February 1 each year. Application is competitive.
