To Register for the Nurse Aide Training Program

1. Meet with and Academic Advisor.
2. Supply proof of High School Diploma, GED or score of 62 or above on the reading portion of COMPASS.

2. If you are currently a High School student or under the age of 18, a letter is required from your high school counselor and parent or guardian addressing information needed as stated on page 9 of the course syllabus.
