What Each Kit Contains? (There are 2 kits)

- 1 Logitech Quickcam Camera
- 1 Logitech USB headset with earphones and microphone
- 1 Idea book with technical instructions for setting up and connecting your conference

What Can I Do With It?

The kit is intended to be used in the office or classroom for web-based video conferencing.

Use can be basic or innovative.

- **Guest Lectures** – Connect to subject matter experts and other interesting parties to expand the walls of you classroom. If they need the equipment to connect, the second unit can be loaned to them.
- **Conduct meetings** – Use the technology to connect to individuals or small groups via the Web. By using services such as Skype, you can connect to sites anywhere in the world.
- **Use it for Screencasting** – Using Camtasia screen capture software, you can capture live motion images of your activities when demonstrating computer functions. Use the headset alone to record a narration or add your picture in the presentation for a more personal touch.
