






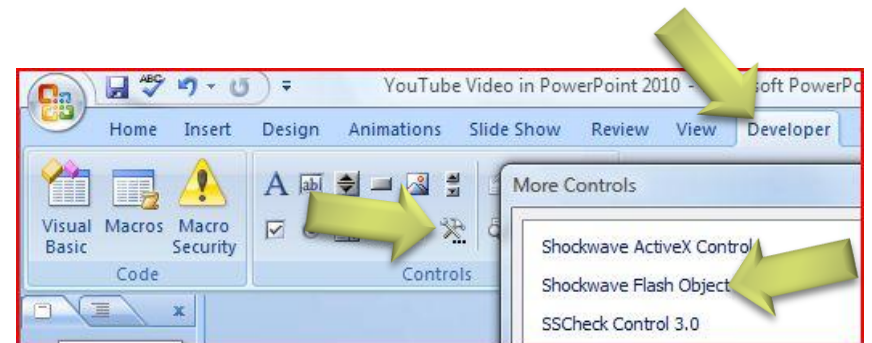

How to Embed a YouTube Video in PowerPoint 2007

Step 1: Set-Up

- ▶ Open PowerPoint
- ▶ Create a blank slide 
- ▶ Is the Developer option active?
 - ▶ Yes? You'll see the Developer tab in your top ribbon
 - ▶ No? Turn on the Developer tab
 - ▶ Click Office button 
 - ▶ Click "PowerPoint Options" button
 - ▶ Check "Show Developer tab in Ribbon" box
 - ▶ Select Developer, find the Controls dialog box and select the "More Controls" icon 
 - ▶ More Controls dialog box opens
 - ▶ Scroll down and select "Shockwave Flash Object"



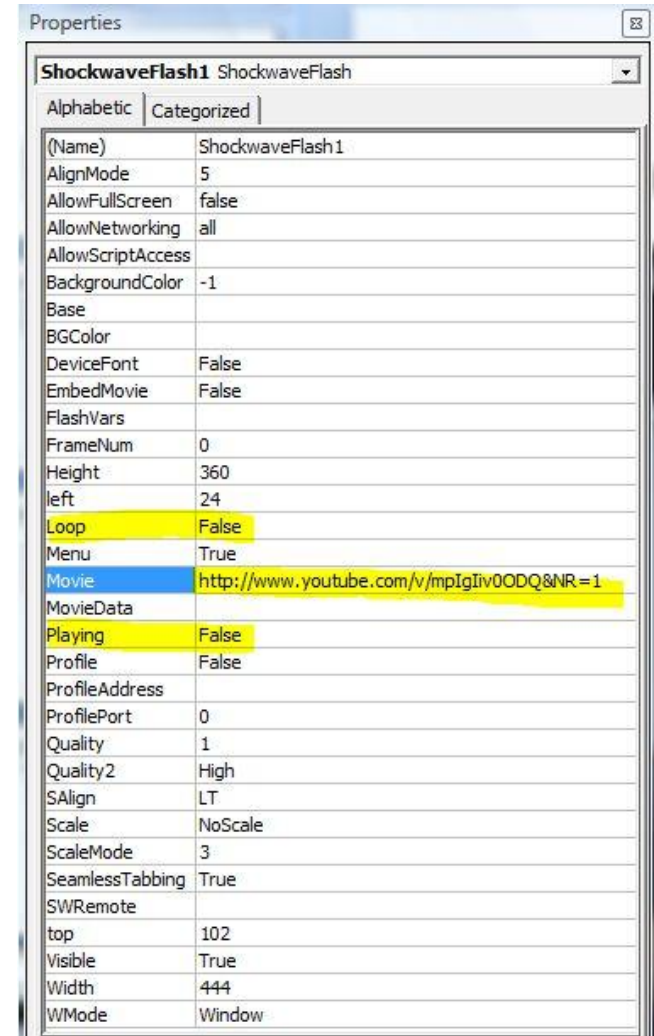
Step 2: Change URL

- ▶ Draw a box on the blank slide for the video
- ▶ Click the box to select it then click “Properties”
- ▶ When the dialog box opens, paste the YouTube video web address (URL) into movie line. Example:
 - ▶ <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mplgliv0ODQ&NR=I>
 - ▶ Change the URL:
 - ▶ Remove this text: **watch?**
 - ▶ <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=mplgliv0ODQ&NR=I>
 - ▶ Replace **=** with **/**
 - ▶ <http://www.youtube.com/v=mplgliv0ODQ&NR=I>
 - ▶ <http://www.youtube.com/v/mplgliv0ODQ&NR=I>

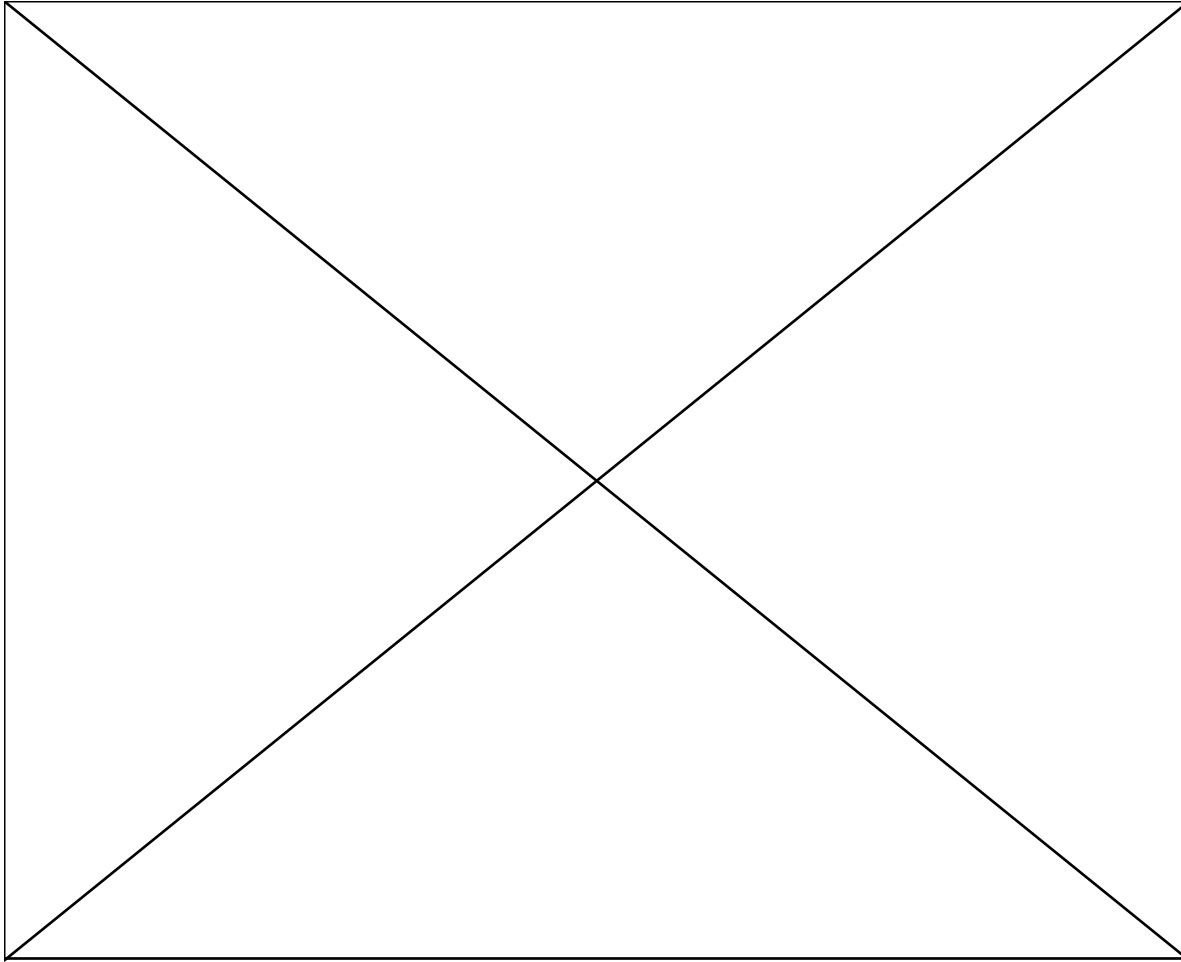


Step 3: Change Settings

- ▶ Do you want the video to loop?
 - ▶ Yes? Leave **Loop** setting at True
 - ▶ No? Click in the loop box and select False in the drop down menu
 - ▶ If you don't change the loop setting to false the video will play over and over
- ▶ Do you want to control when the video plays?
 - ▶ No? Leave the **Playing** setting at True and it will start playing immediately when the slide opens
 - ▶ Yes? Change the playing setting to False
 - ▶ You must click the play button to start the video during your presentation



Your video will look like this:



Last Step

Your YouTube video slide is now ready!

Slide will appear blank

Test it by selecting “Slide Show” tab and then click the “From Current Slide” button

Remember, **you must be connected to the internet for the slide to work**
