

How to Embed a YouTube Video in PowerPoint

- Locate the YouTube Video You Want to Use /Keep Internet Open
- Open PowerPoint
- Make Sure Developer Option is Active in PPT
 - Developer will be one of the Tool Bar options
 - If Not Active, select the Office Button (top left)
 - Select PowerPoint Options (at bottom)
 - Click on “Show Developer Tool in Ribbon”/Click Ok
 - Select Developer, find the Controls dialog box and select the “More Controls” icon (it looks like hammer and wrench)
 - The “More Controls” dialog box will open. Scroll down and select, “Shockwave Flash Object. Click Okay.
- Use Mouse to Size Screen for Video (screen will be blank)

How to Embed a YouTube Video in PowerPoint

- Right Click on Slide, Select “Properties”
- Dialog box with options opens; widen box
- Paste YouTube Video Web Address into **Movie** line on Dialog Box
 - You’ll find this address in the upper right portion of the You Tube Screen. Here’s an example:
 - <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hChq5drjQl4>
 - Remove the following text from the address:
 - watch?
 - <http://www.youtube.com/v=hChq5drjQl4>
 - Replace
 - = sign with / (slash)
 - <http://www.youtube.com/v/hChq5drjQl4>

How to Embed a YouTube Video in PowerPoint

- Other Settings to Change
 - **Change the Loop setting** from True to False. Click in the Loop box and a drop down menu with the True/False will appear
 - If you don't change the Loop setting the video will play over and over (loop)
 - **Change the Playing setting.** If you want the video to start immediately, keep the Playing setting at "True"; If you want to control when the video starts, change the Playing setting to False
- The Slide With Your You Tube Video is now ready to go
 - Note: Slide will be blank
 - Test it by selecting "Slide Show" from the Menu and then "Play Side Show From Beginning"
