The EPA requires that by April 22 of 2010 all contractors who might disturb lead-based paint need to be RRP Certified Renovators.

Facts: by the numbers

- ✦ 35 million homes have lead paint
- ✦ 235,000 firms will need RRP Certification

Did you know that there is a potential \$32,500 per day fine for violation of the rule, which can be enforced by any individual, not just Federal, State or local government employees?

**New EPA Rule
Effective April 22, 2010**

Who Should Attend?

“...EPA issued a rule requiring the use of lead-safe practices and other actions aimed at preventing lead poisoning. Under the rule, beginning in April 2010, contractors performing renovation, repair and painting projects that disturb lead-based paint in homes, child care facilities and schools built before 1978 must be certified and must follow specific work practices to prevent lead contamination.”

The rule requires Individual Certification, at least one RRP Certified Renovator is required at each job site. Certification involves taking a 1-day class from an EPA-accredited Training Provider
