

Kellogg Community College Web Accessibility Guidelines

Policy

Kellogg Community College employees who design or select web pages for delivery by the College to its clientele will ensure the web pages comply with principles known to maximize accessibility to users with disabilities. To this end, the College will establish and enforce a set of guidelines that provides this level of accessibility for people with disabilities.

Guidelines

Effective May 1, 2003, all new or revised Web pages published or hosted by the College must be in compliance with either:

- * Priority 1 Level Checkpoints of the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C) Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 1.0, *or*
- * Federal Rehabilitation Act Section 508, subsections 1194.1 through 1194.22 and subsection 1194.31.

A revised Web page is a Web page where significant redesign of a page or a major revision of the content of a page takes place.
