Qualifications:

- Passionate about using technology to excite students about learning; all courses are offered in a computer lab.
- Excellent communication, presentation, and student engagement skills
- Punctual and organized
- Be available from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday-Thursday, for selected weeks from July 17, 2017 to August 10, 2017 (Note: Schedule may vary slightly depending on enrollment.)
- Participate as a learner in approximately 6-8 hours of online instruction in specific course content. Can be taken on any computer with Internet access.
- Bachelor's degree preferred, but not required
- Teaching experience preferred, but not required

Duties include but are not limited to:

1. Prepare adequately by reviewing and internalizing the Black Rocket curriculum content for the courses to be taught.
2. Prepare for and deliver curriculum daily to groups of up to 24 campers.
3. Familiarize yourself with the necessary software in order to educate and utilize in the classroom.
4. Implement the curriculum as written, adapting it as needed to improve the camper experience or accommodate individual campers.
5. Provide leadership, energy and camp spirit, constantly assessing group dynamics and the needs of individual campers.
6. Work with Assistant Instructors supporting your program area.



7. Establish classroom management expectations and maintain standards of student behavior needed to achieve a positive and productive learning atmosphere.
8. Practice and promote positive interaction with and among students.
9. Assume responsibility for the care of materials, equipment, and facilities.
