

Independent and parents of dependent students, who have not filed a federal tax return, must submit Verification of Non-filing Status Letter. Only the IRS can provide this letter. Below are steps to request the letter online or for a paper letter to be mailed to your address.

ONLINE REQUEST

1. Go to <https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript>
2. Select the “Get Transcript ONLINE button”
3. Create an account or log on with existing username*
4. Request “Verification of Non-filing letter” for previous work year or tax year you are requesting
5. Once you have received your letter, print, sign, date, and submit the letter to KCC’s Financial Aid Office

**To create an account you must be able to verify an email address, filing status, account numbers for loan, credit card, mortgage, and your mobile number must be associated with your name.*

PAPER REQUEST

1. Download form, 4506-T from <https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f4506t.pdf>
2. Complete lines 1 – 4, following instructions on page 2 of the form. On Line 3: Enter the non-filer’s street address and zip or postal code. Use the address currently on file with the IRS
3. Line 6: Enter tax form number 1040
4. Check box for line #7 to request the Verification of Non-filing letter
5. Line 9: enter last day of the previous work year or tax year for which are requesting i.e. for the 2016 year, you’d enter 12/31/2016
6. Check the signatory box stating that you have the authority to sign the 4506-T
7. Enter phone number, sign, and date the form
8. Mail or fax the completed form to the address/number listed on page 2 of the 4506-T form that corresponds with your state of residence
9. Once the 4506-T form is received/accepted by the IRS, the Verification of non-filing letter will be mailed within 10 business days
10. Sign the Verification of Non-filing letter and submit it to the Financial Aid Office at Kellogg Community College. Make sure to include student’s name and ID # on the letter.

<p>Caution: If the tax transcript is being mailed to a third party, ensure that you have filed in lines 6 through 9 before signing. Sign and date the form once you have filed in these lines. Completing these steps helps to protect your privacy. Once the IRS discloses your tax transcript to the third party listed on line 5, the IRS has no control over what the third party does with the information. If you would like to limit the third party's authority to disclose your transcript information, you can specify this limitation in your written agreement with the third party.</p>				
6 Transcript requested. Enter the tax form number here (1040, 1065, 1120, etc.) and check the appropriate box below. Enter only one tax form number per request. ▶				
a Return Transcript, which includes most of the line items of a tax return as filed with the IRS. A tax return transcript does not reflect changes made to the account after the return is processed. Transcripts are only available for the following returns: Form 1040 series, Form 1065, Form 1120, Form 1120-A, Form 1120-H, Form 1120-L, and Form 1120S. Return transcripts are available for the current year and returns processed during the prior 3 processing years. Most requests will be processed within 10 business days <input type="checkbox"/>				
b Account Transcript, which contains information on the financial status of the account, such as payments made on the account, penalty assessments, and adjustments made by you or the IRS after the return was filed. Return information is limited to items such as tax liability and estimated tax payments. Account transcripts are available for most returns. Most requests will be processed within 10 business days <input type="checkbox"/>				
c Record of Account, which provides the most detailed information as it is a combination of the Return Transcript and the Account Transcript. Available for current year and 3 prior tax years. Most requests will be processed within 10 business days <input type="checkbox"/>				
7 Verification of Nonfiling, which is proof from the IRS that you did not file a return for the year. Current year requests are only available after June 15th. There are no availability restrictions on prior year requests. Most requests will be processed within 10 business days <input checked="" type="checkbox"/>				
8 Form W-2, Form 1099 series, Form 1098 series, or Form 5498 series transcript. The IRS can provide a transcript that includes data from these information returns. State or local information is not included with the Form W-2 information. The IRS may be able to provide this transcript information for up to 10 years. Information for the current year is generally not available until the year after it is filed with the IRS. For example, W-2 information for 2011, filed in 2012, will likely not be available from the IRS until 2013. If you need W-2 information for retirement purposes, you should contact the Social Security Administration at 1-800-772-1215. Most requests will be processed within 10 business days <input type="checkbox"/>				
<p>Caution: if you need a copy of Form W-2 or Form 1099, you should first contact the payer. To get a copy of the Form W-2 or Form 1099 filed with your return, you must use Form 4506 and request a copy of your return, which includes all attachments.</p>				
9 Year or period requested. Enter the ending date of the year or period, using the mm/dd/yyyy format. If you are requesting more than four years or periods, you must attach another Form 4506-T. For requests relating to quarterly tax returns, such as Form 941, you must enter each quarter or tax period separately. 12 / 31 / 20XX				
<p>Caution: Do not sign this form unless all applicable lines have been completed. **For the year, please use the Tax Year Information FAFSA is requesting**</p>				
<p>Signature of taxpayer(s). I declare that I am either the taxpayer whose name is shown on line 1a or 2a, or a person authorized to obtain the tax information requested, if the request applies to a joint return, at least one spouse must sign. If signed by a corporate officer, 1 percent or more shareholder, partner, managing member, guardian, tax matters partner, executor, receiver, administrator, trustee, or party other than the taxpayer, I certify that I have the authority to execute Form 4506-T on behalf of the taxpayer.
